<b>2</b>	<p><b>Dreams or Thoughts</b> What would your character be dreaming about or thinking about? Add your ideas near the top of the paper.</p>	<b>8</b>	<p><b>Prediction</b> Make a prediction about what might happen to the character. Add words in a think bubble near the top of the page.</p>
<b>3</b>	<p><b>Words</b> What does your character say or what might your character say? Add words near his or her mouth.</p>	<b>9</b>	<p><b>Setting</b> Where and when does the story take place? Add words to a clock drawn at the bottom left of the paper.</p>
<b>4</b>	<p><b>Actions</b> What has your character done or what does he or she plan to do? Near the hands, write about important actions.</p>	<b>10</b>	<p><b>Adjectives</b> Give two adjectives that describe your character. Write each word on the body of the character.</p>
<b>5</b>	<p><b>Love</b> Who or what does your character love or have strong feelings about? Add details near the "heart" of your character.</p>	<b>11</b>	<p><b>Symbol</b> Draw a symbol that represents the character somewhere on the paper.</p>
<b>6</b>	<p><b>Places</b> Where has your character traveled or where would he or she like to go? Add details near your character's feet.</p>	<b>12</b>	<p><b>Toad</b> Illustrate the toad and in a few words, describe it's meaning in the story.</p>
